Near every college campus, there is always a restaurant that students flock to. Nick Tahou Hots located in Rochester, New York is one such establishment. A favorite of University of Rochester and Rochester Institute of Technology students, Nick Tahou's is most famous for its signature dish - "the Garbage Plate." Created for a college student who long ago asked for a "plate with all the garbage" on it, the Garbage Plate remains not only one of the most famous dishes around, but is also considered a rite of passage for college students in the Rochester area. Open twenty-four hours a day, Nick Tahou Hots is a late night staple, most popular after the bars close around 2 AM.

When ordering a Garbage Plate, one has a choice of two of the following meaty items: hamburger, cheeseburger, hot dog, steak, sausage, chicken, ham, fish, eggs or grilled cheese. They then smother it with your choice of macaroni salad, home fries, baked beans, or french fries. The plate is then topped with Nick's special "hot sauce" along with mustard and onions. All of this is shoveled down with the
