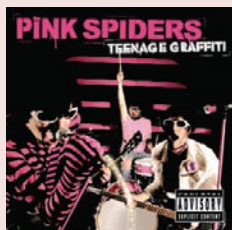
## The Pink Spiders

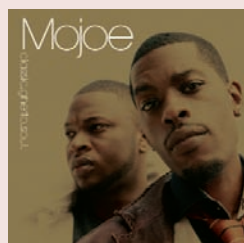


## The Architect

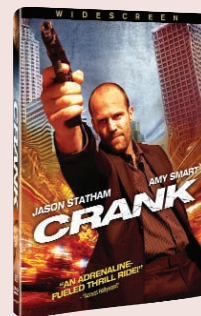
## Crank
