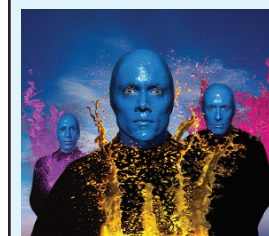
### MI-5 Volume 1-4 Available Now BBC Video
