University Project Wins Awards and Customers!

The challenge for Food Science students at Chapman University, in Orange, California was to develop a food product for a future colony on Mars. The item had to use products grown only in the colony, use minimum water, generate minimum waste, satisfy nutritional requirements and create no crumbs. Gerrie Adams conceived the idea of taking real pizza dough and adding special ingredients then baking for a crispy snack. Professor Dr. Prakash mentored Gerrie and team in the formulation of the snack now known as Pizzettos®. The snack was entered in the 2003 NASA FTCSC National Food Product Development Competition for use by future astronauts and won! After graduating, Gerrie joined with Dr. Prakash to start Xengaru Fun Foods, LLC to commercialize Pizzettos®. Pizzettos® has been available to Southern California School Districts as a food which meets nutritional standards for snacks sold in elementary schools.
